Mayo Girls DELF Preparation



An exciting endeavor to chronicle Rajasthan's ancient water systems advances into its second phase in Udaipur. This initiative holds particular significance for the city, renowned for its lakes, especially given the commendable efforts already underway at the **City Palace of Udaipur**, where water conservation stands as a paramount objective.

Led by **Creadhle** in partnership with **Alliance Française Jaipur**, **Aayojan School of Architecture and Jaipur Virasat Foundation**, the project kicked off its inaugural week with a water documentation art project, engaging students from **Maharana Mewar Public School** and **Rockwoods School Udaipur**.

Led by French architect **Celia Lebarbey** and filmmaker **Marylene Negro**, the objective of this project is to find innovative and engaging ways to document the architectural water harvesting marvels in Rajasthan through the lens of art, cinema, and graphic narration.



Leïla Slimani is a French writer and journalist of Moroccan ancestry. In 2016 she was awarded the Prix Goncourt for her novel Chanson Douce. Slimani takes the reader in the spiritual odyssey of a woman who comes to murder the two children she has been taking care of for several years. The novel deals with the denunciation of much deeper concerns intrinsically tied to our society – racial and social inequalities.


A young woman leaves Douala, the economic capital of Cameroon, and takes the direction of the village where she grew up, where the women of her family raised her, teaching her the rites, the traditions, the history of her family. Since then she carries these stories without knowing what to do with them, and visions that remind her that she belongs to a long line of powerful women. Her arrival in the village shakes her people. Nothing prepared her for this return, the awakening of visions and the role she could play in her community.

A magnificent first novel that questions in a new way the opposition between tradition and modernity. The author uses magic realism to question the place of women who think, dream and shape the future.

2150. The world has changed significantly. Damage caused by climate change and the resurgence of certain deadly diseases have drastically reduced the world's population. Nature has taken back control and the survivors are spread out over different urban zones. Simone, 50, is an astronaut who has been in training for a controversial one-way space mission. DEFI INTER-ALLIANCE JOIN THE MADNESS!


