Third Space: The Future of Edutainment

Third Space in Udaipur was the central venue for the Olympic Festival, which took place from July 26 to August 11. On July 27, Third Space inaugurated its newly constructed cinema hall, featuring 180 seats, including 35 recliners and wheelchair-accessible options. The state-of-the-art facility was equipped with advanced technology, such as the Barco SP4K laser projector and the QSC 7.1 channel Dolby sound system, ensuring a high-quality viewing experience. The cinema's mission was to provide a premium entertainment experience and serve as a platform for emerging filmmakers from Udaipur, offering them an opportunity to showcase their films in a modern and accessible setting.

Mahila Jan Adhikar Samiti

Mahila Jan Adhikar Samiti started as a collective of women which came into being as an organization in 1995 to fight for Violence against Women. The collective believes in the leadership of women at all levels of action for social change. One programme of this association is using football for freedom, unity and solidarity for girls ages 10-18. Girls teams had already played two nationals, state and district tournaments. 4 girls are D-Licensed coaches and became the first women coaches in the district. The objective was to use sports, in particular football, seen as a 'male sport' to break gender norms and help girls move beyond their family confines, take greater control over their bodies, be able to better negotiate their own aspirations and ultimately prevent their own early marriage, as well as those of others. Originally, it was proposed that 60 girls from four villages each be targeted as participants but the count was extended due to a favorable response from the girls. Today more than 400 girls play football across 11 villages in Ajmer and Kekdi district of Rajasthan. This program is conducted in collaboration with Alliance Française Jaipur, Mahila Jan Adhikar Samiti & Rajasthan Football Association.


City Significance

Empowering Girls Through Football: A Competition to Celebrate Change

On Saturday, August 10, the competition took place between 02:00 and 05:00 p.m. at Sanskriti School in Ajmer. Three teams competed fiercely in the event, which was open to the public. Sanjana Sarkar, the director of Alliance Française Jaipur, was present during the event to show their support and enthusiasm.

On the same day, the women's gold medal football game was held in Paris, France.

Mahila Jan Adhikar Samiti, which began as a collective of women in 1995 dedicated to combating violence against women, had initiated a significant program using football as a tool for empowerment. The program, aimed at girls aged 10-18, had already seen participation in two national, one state, and several district tournaments. Notably, four girls had achieved D-Licensed coach status, becoming the first women coaches in their district.

Initially, the program had planned to involve 60 girls from four villages, but the enthusiastic response led to an expansion. By now, more than 400 girls across 11 villages in Ajmer and Kekdi districts of Rajasthan were playing football.

This initiative, conducted in collaboration with Alliance Française Jaipur, Mahila Jan Adhikar Samiti, and the Rajasthan Football Association, was celebrated in conjunction with the ongoing Olympics in Paris, highlighting the intersection of sports and social change.

Additionally, the festival strengthened social ties within communities, fostering a sense of unity and collective identity. 

Udaipur Olympic Festival at Third Space from July 26 to August 11

Udaipur | From July 26 to August 11, an Olympic Festival is being organized at Third Space in collaboration with the French Embassy's cultural wing, Alliance Française, and the French Institute. This festival will feature several activities. including screening of Olympic Games, tennis tournaments, table tennis, and more. Ketan Bhatt, the CEO of the Heritage Institute, shared this information during a press briefing on Tuesday. He added that several Olympic athletes from across the country will be invited to inspire people through their experiences, especially the youth of Udaipur.

Ketan Bhatt stated that the festival will also include sports competitions, cultural performances, and workshops for children and adults. He mentioned that Udaipur is one of the few cities in India where such an extensive Olympic festival is being organized, and that it is a matter of great pride for the city.

Additionally, the festival will include screenings of documentaries and films related to the Olympics, which will be shown every evening. The films will be screened in both Udaipur and Jaipur, with screenings in other cities like Jodhpur and Kota being planned as well.
