## Jaipur hosts the National Network Meet

In April 2025, Jaipur had the honour of hosting the **National Network Meeting** of the Alliances Françaises in India, bringing together representatives from the **15 centres** in India and their **10 annexes**.

This annual gathering fosters dialogue and collaboration within the network, focusing on innovative strategies to make French language and culture more accessible across India.



This meet, hosted across different cities each year, is a space for dialogue and brainstorming. Under the leadership of the directors and presidents of the Alliances, the French Institute in India and the Embassy of France in India, this meeting outlines the **vision and objectives** for each year.

This year, AF Jaipur decided to host it in a somewhat different manner! Set against the stunning backdrop of the Diggi Palace, these three days were a treat for our guests, who witnessed the true blue hospitality of Rajasthan, complete with folk traditions, royal heritage and culinary practices.

## David Foenkinoes

In February 2025, Alliance Française Jaipur had the pleasure of hosting **David Foenkinoes**, a celebrated French novelist, screenwriter, and director, in collaboration with Alliance Française du Bengale.

Set against the backdrop of the Mubarak Mahal at the **City Palace of Jaipur**, *The Many Lives of David Foenkinoes* featured a conversation with Mohit Batra, a third generation bookseller and owner of Rajat Book Corner, offering the audience a window into the author's creative world, delivered in his signature blend of wit, humour and depth.

The following evening saw the first-ever public screening of Foenkinoes' acclaimed film *La Délicatesse*, based on his novel, in Jaipur and in partnership with **The Open Space Society**.

Shilpi Batra, director of TOSS, opened the screening with a conversation exploring the adaptation of his novel for the screen and sharing reflections on the art of filmmaking.

A memorable evening that brought together literature, cinema, and cultural exchange in the heart of Rajasthan with one of the most celebrated contemporary authors in France.

## Johary Ravoloson

One fine late spring evening, Alliance Française Jaipur had the pleasure of welcoming Franco-Malagasy author **Johary Ravoloson** for an evening of literary conversation and creative exploration.

The evening opened with a discussion around his novel *Tribunal des Cailloux*, moderated by **Dr. Nidhi Raisinghani**, Head of the Department of European Languages, Literature and Cultural Studies at the University of Rajasthan. The conversation was interpreted into English by **Sanjana Sarkar**, Director of AFJ Jaipur, allowing the audience to engage fully with Ravoloson's reflections on literature, identity, and language.

This was followed by a writing workshop, where nearly fifty participants, seated across the AFJ lawns, collaborated on their very first ***exquisite cadaver***, a playful and poetic group writing exercise inspired by surrealist traditions.

A celebration of words, creativity, and community, the evening shone a spotlight on the literary voices of the **Indian Ocean**, honouring the diversity and depth of **Francophonie** in all its glory.

## Gaspard Combes

As part of **Jaipur Art Week 2025**, French installation artist **Gaspard Combes**, who was in residence as a part of the *Villa Swagatam*, in Jodhpur in collaboration with *Public Arts Trust of India*, led a unique sculpture-making workshop at Jawahar Kala Kendra earlier this year.

The session brought together students from institutions like IICD, IIGJ, Maharani Gayatri Devi School, Neerja Modi World School and the Indian Women Impact NGO for a hands-on creative experience. In this live performance workshop, participants were invited to reshape everyday objects - no rules, only open-ended exploration and imagination. Using the typical, colourful plastic tubs commonly seen in any Indian household, Gaspard and the students pushed the boundaries of imagination.

Form, space, and spontaneity all came together for this workshop, offering young creators a fresh lens to view the ordinary as extraordinary.

## The Kindness Meal

**Food Culture Playdate**, a pioneering initiative by the good folks at The Kindness Meal, was recently conducted at **Maharana Mewar Public School** in Udaipur. Having already been introduced in select institutions across the country, from Chandigarh to Pune to Hyderabad, this first-of-its-kind educational experience made its debut in the city, engaging approximately 30 students from classes 6 to 8 over two days.

Facilitated by **Dipali Khandelwal**, founder of **The Kindness Meal** initiative, the session offered an **immersive journey into food heritage through a blend of storytelling, sensory exploration, and traditional games.** This innovative format, unlike any conventional classroom activity, enabled students to reconnect with ancestral knowledge while cultivating an awareness of sustainable food practices.

The program represents a forward-thinking step in educational engagement, encouraging curiosity, cultural pride, and a values-based approach to food and community. We extend our sincere thanks to the **French Institute in India** for their generous support in making this multi-city tour possible.

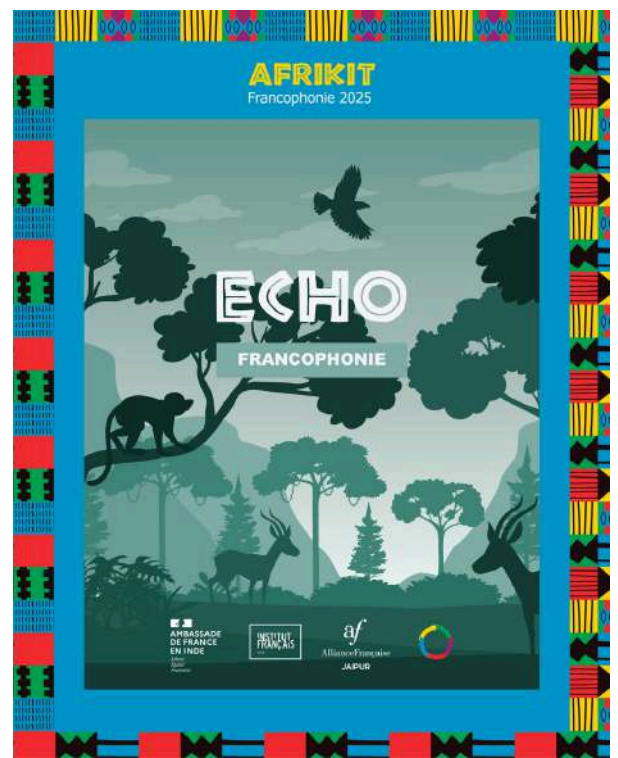
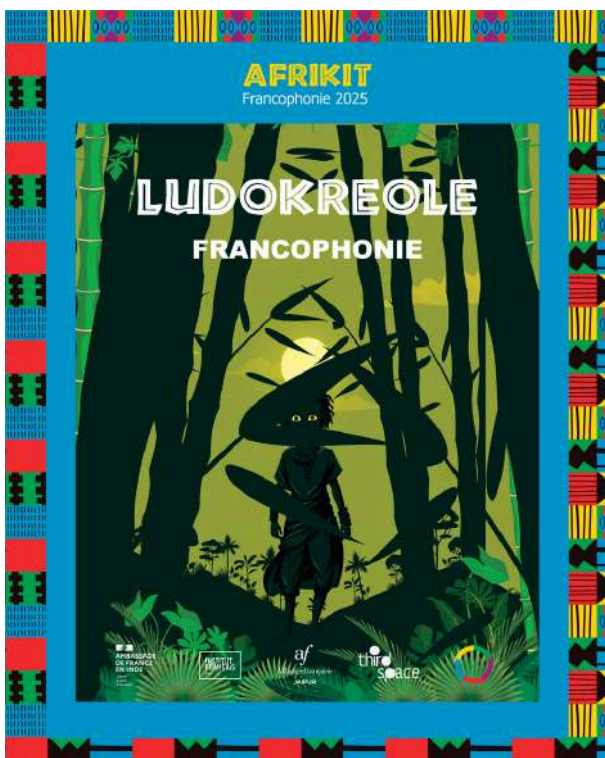
## Celebrating Africa through words and sounds

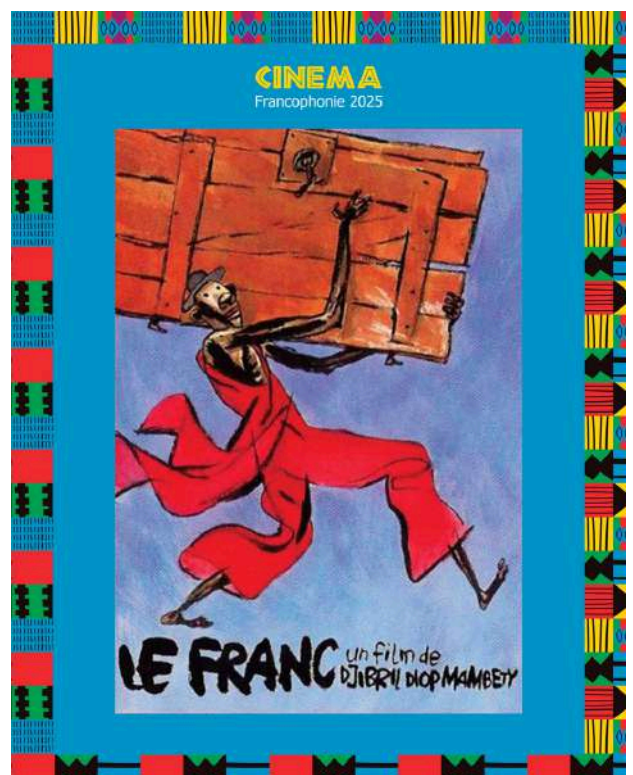
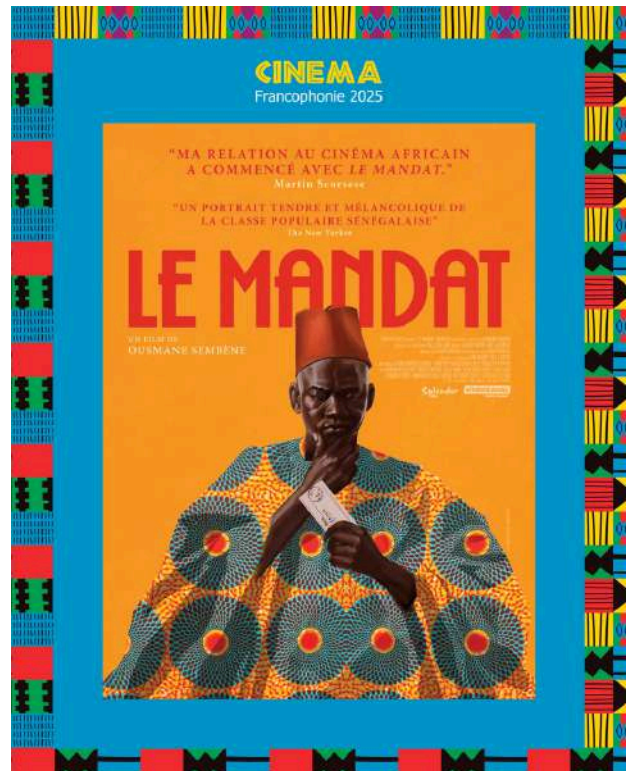

Each course is co-led by French-speaking teachers from different Alliances, sharing instruction and bringing diverse perspectives. A unified pedagogical framework ensures consistency while fostering engagement and community across borders. The program is fully online, allowing participants to interact and exchange with learners across the globe, without the need to travel!

### **Francophonie 2025: Launch of FLE-X Afrique**

With the arrival of **April**, we were delighted to relaunch our monthly Cinema Under the Stars program—an ongoing initiative that invites audiences to experience the beauty of French cinema in an open-air setting on the AFJ lawns.

The April screening of **Rogue**, selected by our teacher Vishakha, was a fitting conclusion to Francophonie celebrations. Directed by *Franco-Algerian filmmaker Farid Bentoumi*, this ecological thriller resonated deeply with viewers, sparking a lively discussion on global environmental issues and the importance of ecological responsibility.

In June, as a tribute to the **Cannes Film Festival**, our teacher **Gaurav** selected **En Corps** for the open-air screening. Directed by *Cédric Klapisch*, whose latest film *La Venue de l'Avenir* was showcased in the **Out of Competition category** at the Cannes film festival this year, the film explores themes of resilience and human strength through the story of a gifted ballet dancer facing life after injury. Praised for its cinematography and emotional impact, the film struck a powerful chord with our audience.

Each screening is followed by a discussion and Q&A session, offering an opportunity to reflect on the film's themes and foster thoughtful, engaging debate among the viewers.


This year, Siyahi brings three key initiatives to the forefront:

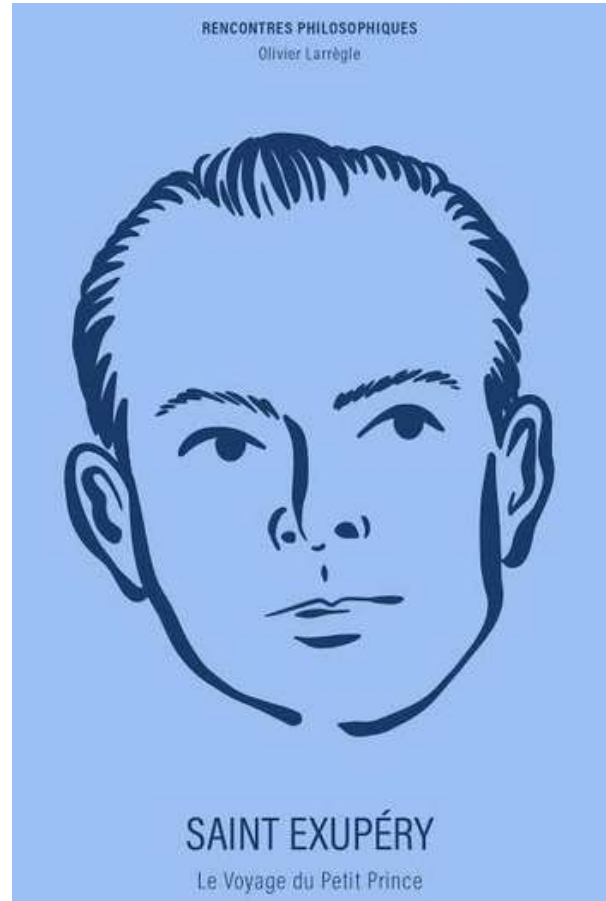
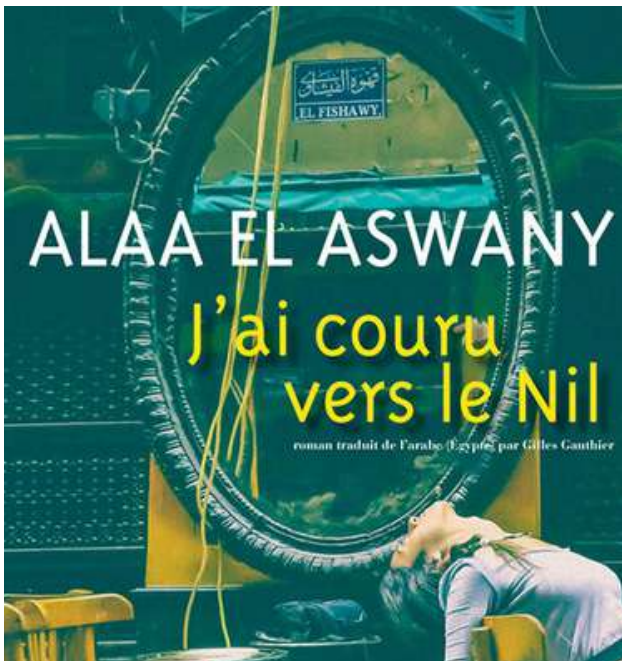
**Our course director, Girija, picks the book of the month!**

French musician David Walters is bringing his sunshine-soaked sound straight from Marseille to Jaipur on the 5th of July!

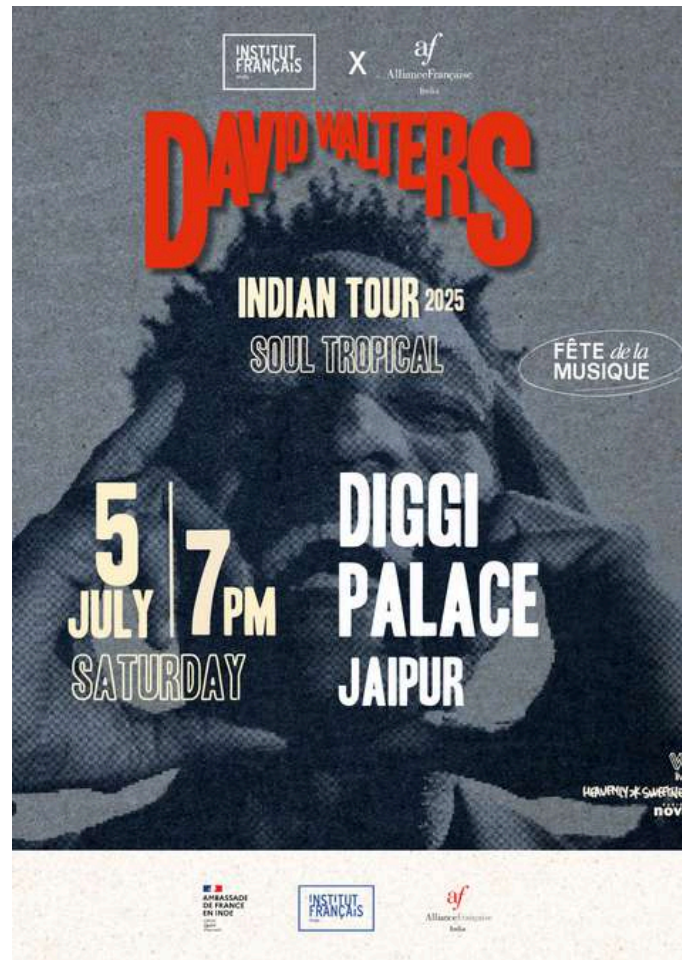
